| <p>Board Members Discussion: It was confirmed that the Visitors Centre is open for all and therefore can be funded by Leader.</p> <p>The amount of funding going into the project and what element of the visitors centre is being funded was also discussed. Mr Jimmy Taaffe confirmed that WLP are only funding a small percentage of the visitors centre 9.36075% and that it will not be possible to say what the exact elements are. Funding is going towards the overall cost of the build.</p> <p>It was noted that there are no jobs created by this funding. Mr Jimmy Taaffe confirmed that there are about 30 nuns ranging in age from 24 to 80 and that they will be running the centre.</p> <p>A Board Member raised their concern that looking at the money it appears as if they have enough to complete the work without funding? Mr Jimmy Taaffe said that it is a legitimate concern and that it was reviewed quite closely by the Evaluation Committee. When they looked at the income half the nuns are elderly and their income source mainly comes from the old age pension. They are no longer milking and need an alternative income source. The Visitor Centre will be a revenue stream for them.</p> <p>While it might appear that funds are plentiful the order basically had to rebuild the front of the convent which is not part of this application.</p> <p>A concern was raised in relation to the point in the Evaluation Committees discussion that the way it was worded it might appear as if funding was going to support the nuns in their old age whereas in fact it is going towards the building of the visitors/wellness centre. This should be made clear.</p> <p>It was suggested that it should be linked to the St. Declan's Way Walk.</p> <p>Board Members agreed that the Visitors Centre is being located in a beautiful location and will bring footfall to the area.</p> |                         |                                                                                                                       |
