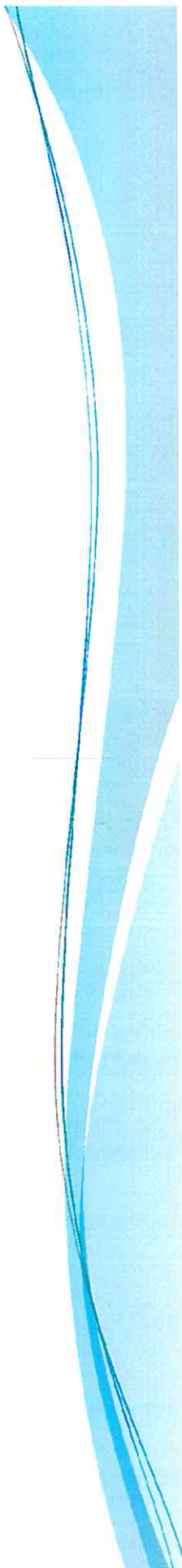


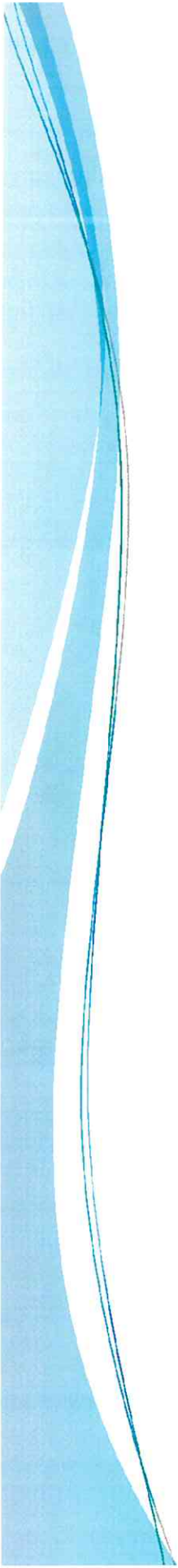

 - Disadvantaged areas

 - Rural and urban



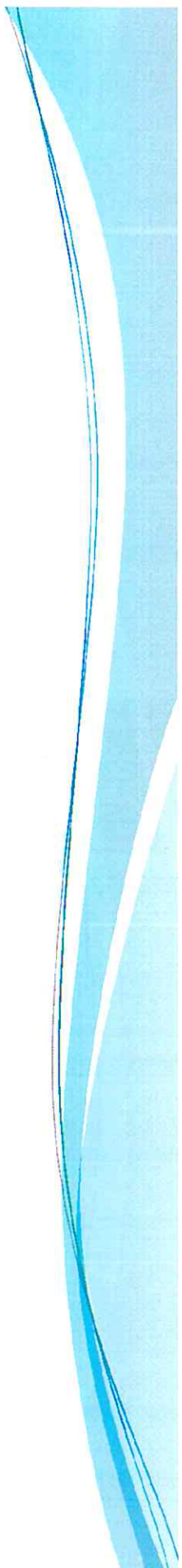
- MIF – new communities ...LCDC initiative

- Skills sub committee –recommendations to address future needs

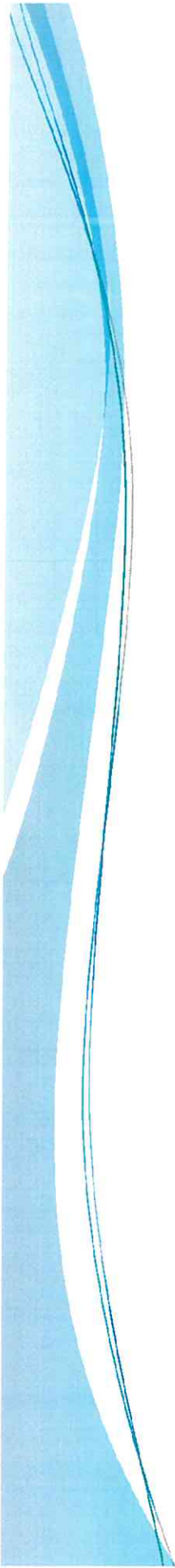
- Rural Development Co-ordination Group

- Grants schemes: CEP; RAPID; Men's Sheds



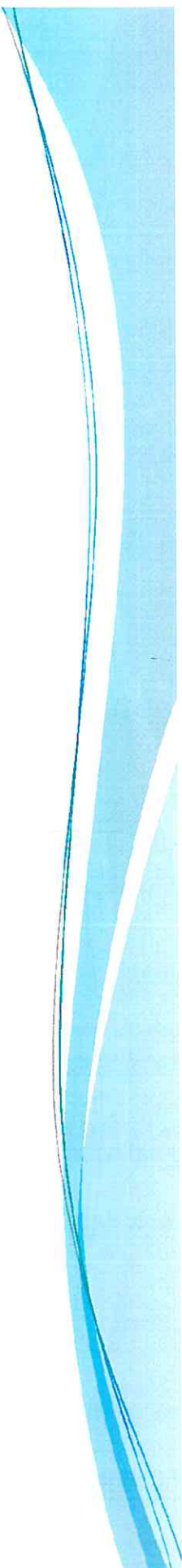
Other successes...

- Adopt LDS
- Review LDS
- RDP/ LEADER Projects:
 - Approved: >€3.5m
 - Paid out: >€2m
 - Benchmarking: 1st in payments and 5th on projects approved as a % of project budget
- Projects must be linked to LECP, e.g. Rural tourism
- Sustaining and growing employment in rural areas



Strategic focus
