They considered it worth supporting as it will provide 3 to 4 highly skilled jobs in Cappoquin with salaries of €60,000 +. They also said that the promoter should consider alternative uses for the machine as a back-up plan as the project is high risk. It was noted that the concern regarding the risk element was reflected in the Evaluation Committee scoring of 66%.
